#### About HackBlagoevgrad

**HackBlagoevgrad** is a week-long IT forum which aims at combining the formats of a conference consisting of several presentations and workshops given by professionals in the field, and a hackathon during which the participants work in teams on developing certain technological products.

The idea behind its organization was born when a group of young people studying and working in the IT field got together. Since we were all related in one way or another to the city of Blagoevgrad, we saw the dire need of bringing such a forum to the local audience. After thorough research and extensive planning today we present to you the shape of what was once just a whim and will soon enough come to life.

The first edition of **HackBlagoevgrad** will take place in the week November 14-20, 2016 on the Campus of the American University in Bulgaria.

### ? HACKBLAGOEVGRAD

The topic for the event is **Hack for Future**. This means that participants are encouraged to work on any idea for a product that they consider innovative. The goal is to lead the team members into thinking out of the box and for a positive change on a local and national scale.

#### Schedule

As scheduled, the first **HackBlagoevgrad** event will go in the following way:

*Monday through Thursday* (*November 14-17, 2016*): Starting at 7:30PM companies' professionals give presentations/workshops in one of the aulas in Balkanski Academic Center, AUBG Campus.

*Friday (November 18, 2016)*: Around 6PM participants and mentors gather for the kick-off of the hackathon weekend. The participants discuss their ideas and form teams (if they have not done so previously at the time of registration or during the presentations'/workshops' days). After that, the teams head for their personal workspaces in the Sports Hall of the ABF Student Center, AUBG Campus, and start working.

**Saturday** (November 19, 2016): The participants continue working on their ideas throughout the whole day/night and the mentors help them.

**Sunday** (November 20, 2016): The participants finish up their projects. In the evening every team presents what they have done in front of the jury and an open audience. After that comes the voting and the jury announces the winners who receive prizes.

#### Audience

On **HackBlagoevgrad** we aim at gathering primarily students in one of the many IT related disciplines who come from:

- The American University in Bulgaria (approx. 1 000 students in total, out of whom around 250 in IT-related disciplines)
- The South-West University "Neofit Rilski" (approx. 11 500 students in total, out of whom around 800 in IT-related disciplines)
- The High School of Mathematics "Acad. Sergey Pavlovich Korolyov" in Blagoevgrad (approx. 900 students in total, out of whom around 500 in ITrelated disciplines)
- Other educational institutions around the country.

Furthermore, we will gladly welcome anyone who is interested in participating in such a forum.

We expect that the audience of **HackBlagoevgrad** will be formed by young people who are eager to learn about up-to-date technologies, share their plans with fellows, and set their sights on developing innovative products.

**Note:** Since the prospective participants in **HackBlagoevgrad** come from different nationalities, the official language spoken throughout the forum will be English.

#### Organizers

We, the people behind the scenes of **HackBlagoevgrad**, are a group of young enthusiasts who believe in the future of technology and in the abilities of our fellows to take the initiative and make a change.

Currently, the main responsibility for the organization of the week-long event is shared between the Computer Science Students Union (CSSU) at the American University in Bulgaria, the High School of Mathematics "Acad. Sergey Pavlovich Korolyov" in Blagoevgrad, and other devotees to our common mission. Clearly, our dreams would not have started coming true without the special help and support granted by our partners from HackBulgaria.
